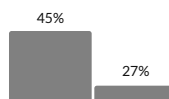

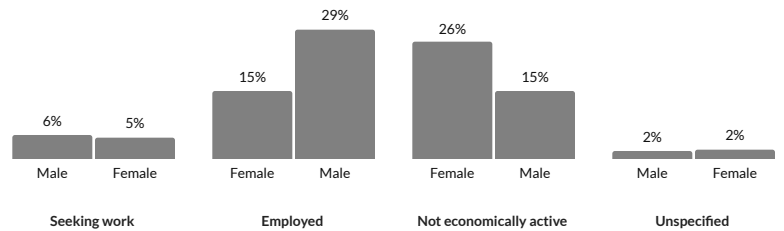

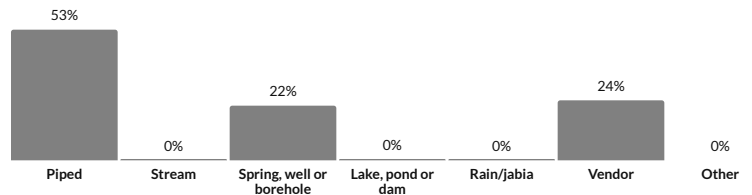

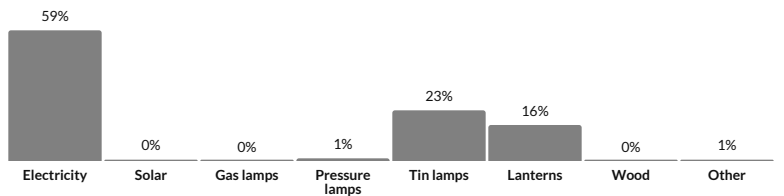

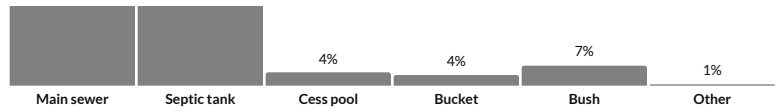

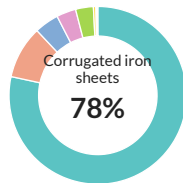

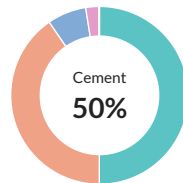

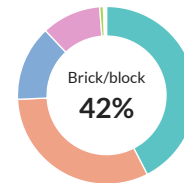

Percent distribution of currently married women age 15-49 by contraceptive method

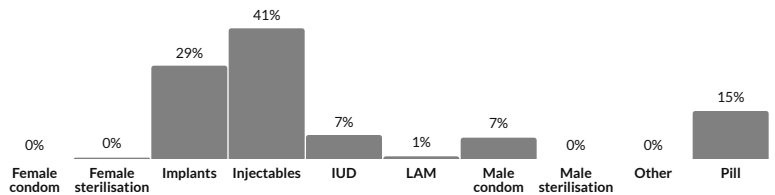

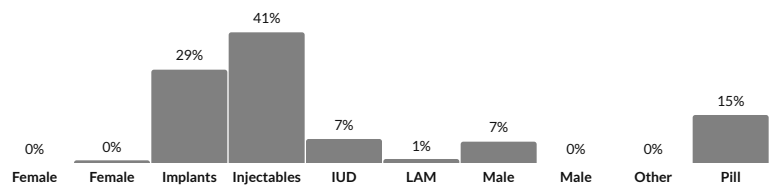

Intermittent Preventive Treatment of pregnant women

The Government of Kenya's policy advocates for pregnant women in malaria endemic areas to receive two doses of intermittent preventive treatment (IPT) in the second and third trimesters in order to reduce the risk of malaria infection. To assess the coverage of this policy, women who had a live birth in the two years before the survey were asked if they had received treatment to prevent malaria during their pregnancy

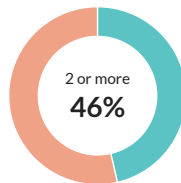

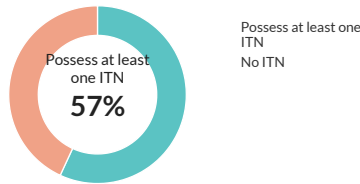

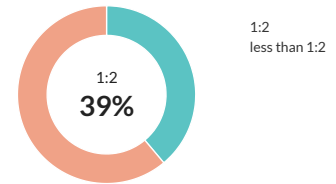

Households that possess at least one insecticide-treated nets (ITNs)



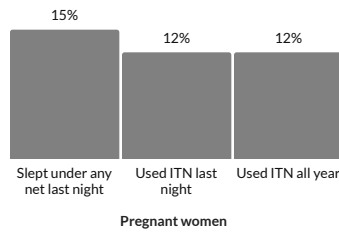

Households that possess an insecticide-treated nets (ITNs) for every 2 people

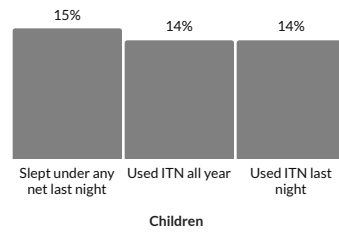

Use of nets by children under age five and pregnant women in all households

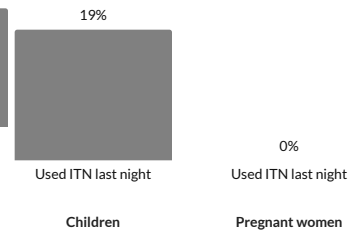

Use of nets by children under age five and pregnant women in all households with at least one insecticide-treated nets (ITNs)



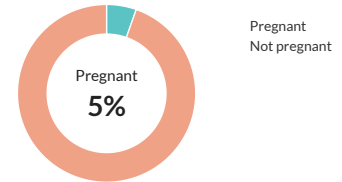

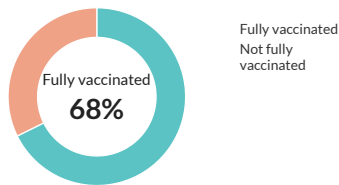

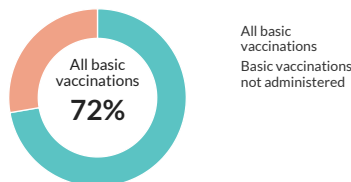

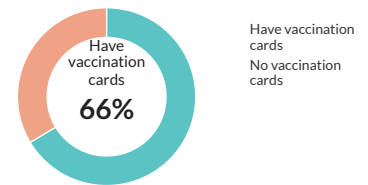

Percentage of children age 12-23 months who received specific vaccines



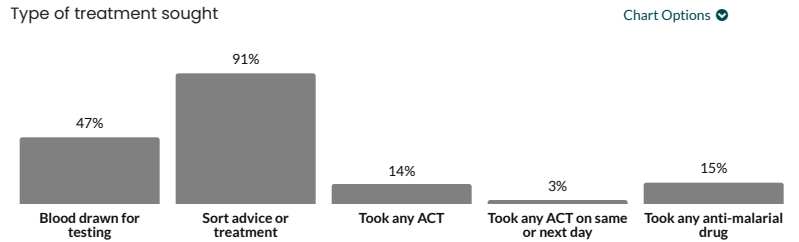

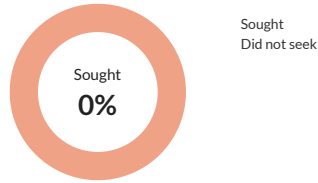

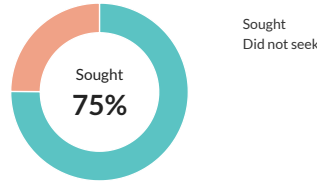

Percentage of children with ARI who sought treatment from health facility or provider



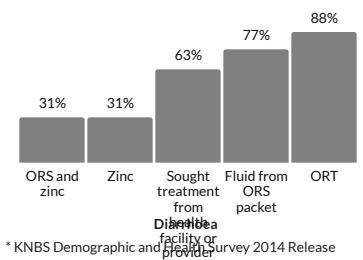

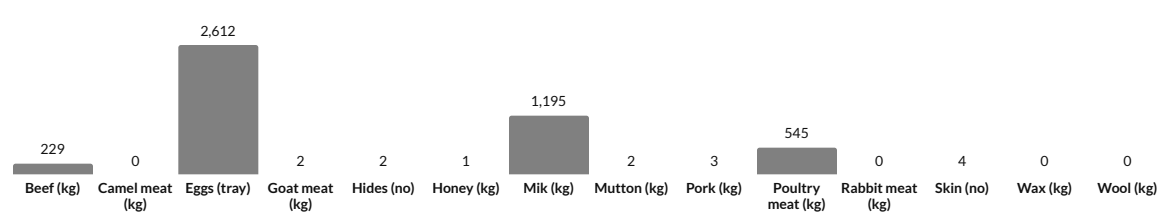

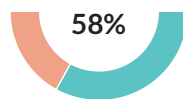

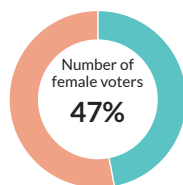

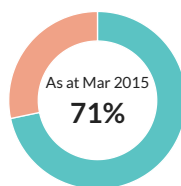

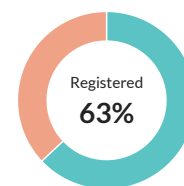

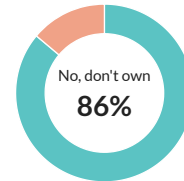

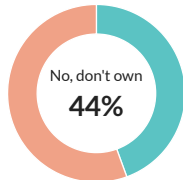

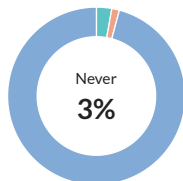

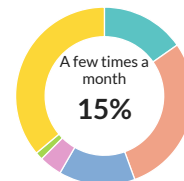

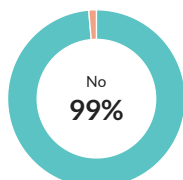

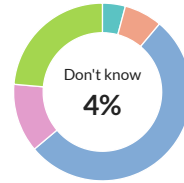

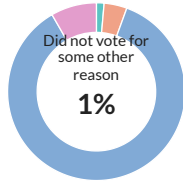

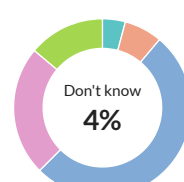

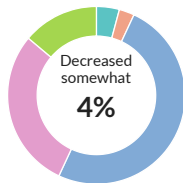

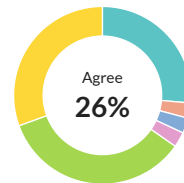

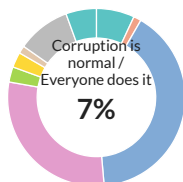

What is your main reason for not reporting corruption?

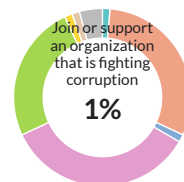

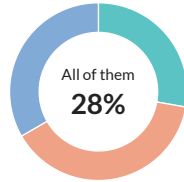

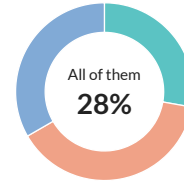

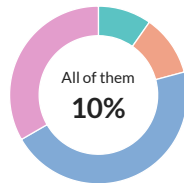

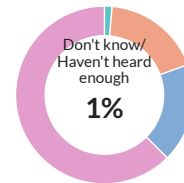

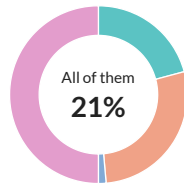

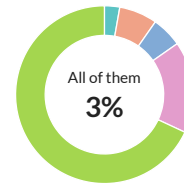

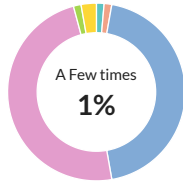

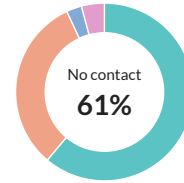

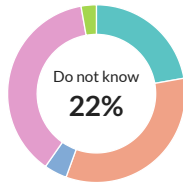

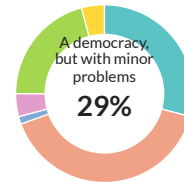

Extent of democracy

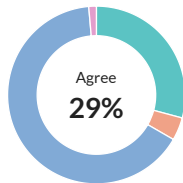

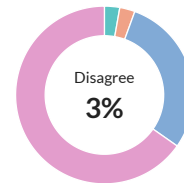

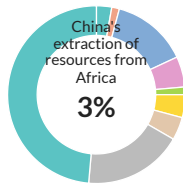

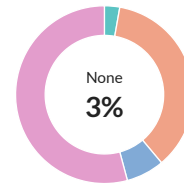
